Maths

We will learn to :

- count on and back from different numbers and know 1 more/less
- continue ordering the days of the week and months of the year
- use ordinal language 1st, 2nd, 3rd..
- use everyday language related to time and introduce months of the year.
- Solve number problems.
- Find the total number of two groups
- Recognise and describe 3D shapes
- Estimate and check by counting

Understanding the World

We will :

- learn ways people celebrate New Year
- to learn about similarities and differences among communities and traditions.
- Observe how things change when they are cooked.
- Using ICT – hand mixers, cameras, film clips, Google maps.

Expressive arts and design

We will learn:

- new songs and rhymes, linked to Chinese New Year.
- to experiment with changing and exploring different sounds
- to build on a large scale - dragon.
- Role play - dressing up/ Chinese restaurant

Literacy

We will continue learning:

- to read and write new letter sounds and sight words and to practise reading 2 syllable words
- to use ICT and non-fiction texts to find out information
- to use finger spaces between words when writing sentences
- start to use capital letters and full stops.

- name and describe 3-d shapes.
- weighing objects
- count forwards and backwards, including in 2s and order numbers.
- add and subtract one-digit numbers.
- half or double small amounts
