Theme Overview ~ Adventurers Ahoy

Breadth of Study

Geography

As we develop our geographical awareness, the children will be able to explain why the discoveries of America were important and how the physical features link to our own here. Year 6 will use satellite mapping tools to find and present geographical information.

Art

The children will expand their awareness and understanding of artists' work during the whole school project - take one photo. We will then learn new artistic techniques in our own creations.

History

Children will research famous Tudor explorers and the significance of their explorations. We will learn why these explorers are considered successful and their legacy today. Year 6 will be presenting their research on Ferdinand Magellan.

PSHE

We will explore the British Value of democracy. Following the creation of our class charter, we will discuss the commonwealth and investigate what happens when they are broken. Year 6, will explore what being part of a community means and the varied institutions which support this.

Through our enquiry question -How are we part of something much bigger than just the UK? We will learn about our Commonwealth, how it is maintained and its role around the world.

Outdoor learning

After investigating explorers from the Tudor era, we will draw on our new learning to create own obstacle courses that recreate these significant journeys.

As a result of our visit to the Mary Rose and HMS Victory, children will understand the challenges of Tudor exploration and the important role both of these boats hold from a historical perspective.

During the second half of this topic, the children will closely examine the physical landscape of North America including the wildlife that inhabits this location before making comparisons to our local area.
