Dear Parents,

Where on earth did that 6 weeks go?! I hope you've all managed to have some kind of holiday or good break from work/home schooling and enjoyed the sunshine (although I personally have loved the thunder and lightning!). These are the final details for supporting you and your family in getting back into the school swing of things and will hopefully ease any worries and enable you to plan for the next fortnight or so.

Year R beckons! We've been beavering away making changes to classrooms and the canopy area ready for your little ones to start with us. To reiterate, this is the timeframe for the next four weeks:

Home visits

These should be booked in already with you. If you haven't got one booked, please email Miss Kirkham directly; <u>c.kirkham@stockbridge.hants.sch.uk</u> and she will make sure you're booked in. Restrictions haven't eased as much as we thought they might back in July so where possible, please meet outside in the garden. Miss Kirkham and Mrs McInnes will bring masks with them. They will not arrive wearing one but will check with you on arrival whether you'd like them to wear them.

We are not anticipating any children in either pre-school or school that week as we will not have sufficient staffing in place with 2 members of staff out on home visits all day every day and new pre-school children coming into the setting for their first visits.

You'll notice that the morning slot children are largely new to us (ie. we don't have their sibling here or they haven't attended our pre-school) which means we know them a little less and have given them the morning slot where we have an extra hour with them.

Drop off and pick up point is through the sliding door opposite the White Hart path entrance – best place to park is the White Hart, High Street or the layby on the A30 and come in through the White Hart gate. If you are picking up siblings from other classes, we recommend you do that FIRST and then come round to Sprat & Winkle.

Week 4 - All in, full time!

Yay! Normality can begin.

What to bring

- For your child's first session, please just bring them, in school uniform.
- Book bag (named!) with a spare pair of pants and socks please
- Please bring their bear
- Packed lunch if you want them to eat food from home.
 PE kit is only needed from Week 4.

Everything else, including a personal water bottle, wellies and waterproofs is provided by us.

What to do at drop off

- Sanitise your child's and your hands using the autosanitiser at the door
- Come into the building through the sliding door
- Help your child find their peg.
- Go out through the classroom to the canopy
- Adults, please between adults, observe at least 1m social distancing at all times.
- Children will play in the canopy area and when Miss Kirkham moves them inside, say goodbye & leave through the gate

What to expect

- Your child will be nervous, it's normal and nothing to worry about. Be positive! They'll take their lead from you!
- Children will play with no social distancing; they are in a bubble and we expect this.
- Tired children! Get routines for bedtime going now so they're well rested.
- Tears yours probably! We know this is a big step, especially after lockdown. If you're worried about anything, please speak to us.
