#### Rainbow Rules

Some of you may be aware we have Rainbow Rules in Pre-school. These are mirrored in school and can be seen to the left.

We will be reinforcing and role modelling good practice and if we see good examples of children demonstrating good use of rainbow rules they may receive a sticker or a certificate. We will be sending home more about this in the near future.

#### Arrival

As COVID restrictions remain in place, we'd like to remind all parents to arrive via the MAIN GATE on Old London Road and leave via the gate by Sprat & Winkle class. This is to ensure effective social distancing measures are maintained. Thank you for your co-operation at these difficult times.

#### Toys

We have had an increasing number of toys bought in from home. We understand from time to time children may require a toy/comforter from home but they will be quickly put away as soon as your child is distracted. We would like to stress these toys can cause upset if lost or required to share them with others which isn't really safe in this COVID era. Please refrain from bringing toys to Pre-School unless agreed with a member of pre-school staff as a strategy for your child. Thank you!

## **Nursery Rhymes**

Our focus for this week and next is Nursery Rhymes. We will be singing a range of traditional rhymes and reading traditional tales such as Goldilocks, Three little pigs, Jack and the beanstalk, Ten in the bed and more.

Ask your child what story they have had today. See if they can recite some of the familiar rhymes. Great language opportunities come from shared learning.
