Tapestry

In pre-school we are lucky to have tapestry, our online learning journals where we can share lots of pictures of what your child has been doing throughout the week with their friends. Tapestry is a safe sharing platform only viewed by school staff and yourselves. We will upload a weekly entry of a sneak peek of all we have been doing. Please share these with your children and ask them about the things they have enjoyed or experienced. If you could also give us a thumbs up (like) we know you have seen it.

You will regularly receive an entry that is personal to your own child and their learning developments as well. Feel free to upload your own entries we love to see what the children get up to at home or with family.

Spring has sprung..... We will be spending an increasing amount of time outside, or with

the doors open as part of the Covid precautionary measures, ensuring lots of ventilation but also as the better weather is here many children enjoy playing in the mud kitchen, riding bikes, digging the sand, climbing and rolling down the hill in the meadow garden. Please ensure your child is suitably dressed in practical clothes ready to have fun! We do have waterproof outfits although some children prefer to bring their own. These can be left on their pegs and used as required. Spare clothes (couple of sets including socks!) wellies and spares can be left on their peg and sent home when we feel they need replenishing. All clothing clearly labelled please. We like to send them home with correct belongings but remembering a whole class and their wardrobe can be tricky!











Drop off and collection times are as follows.

Please ensure you only arrive at your specified time to ensure social distancing measures are maintained for everyones safety. A mask should also be worn at all times. At collection your child will greet you once a member of staff is aware of your arrival.

As your child arrives, please encourage them to use the sanitiser on the wall for their hands after they've hugged you goodbye – this is a key part of our COVID safety measures.
