A few essentials for parents

Contact details: Have you changed jobs, places of work or changed mobile numbers? Please ensure we have up to date contact details. This is essential for your child's safety, this also includes any emergency contacts you may have previously listed.

Absence: If your child is sick or not going to be attending please call the school reception on 01264 810550 and leave a message as to the reason for non-attendance by 9am. Lunches are ordered at this registration time and **all** children need to be accounted for.

Prior Injuries: from time to time children will have bumps and scrapes both at pre-school and with you at home, this is perfectly natural and part of growing and developing physical skills. If an accident occurs at pre-school we complete a red slip and this is sent home with your child to notify you of the incident. A head injury will also be followed up with a phone call to notify you of the bump. If an accident happens in your care we ask the same. Its good practice to share this information and you will be asked to complete a prior injury slip, please allow a few minutes at drop off for this should it be required.

Late collection: All children should be collected by (12 noon for some) 3:15pm. If you have siblings to collect from school, **please collect from pre-school first.** We understand from time to time situations occur, if this is the case call school office immediately to prevent a late collection charge.
