

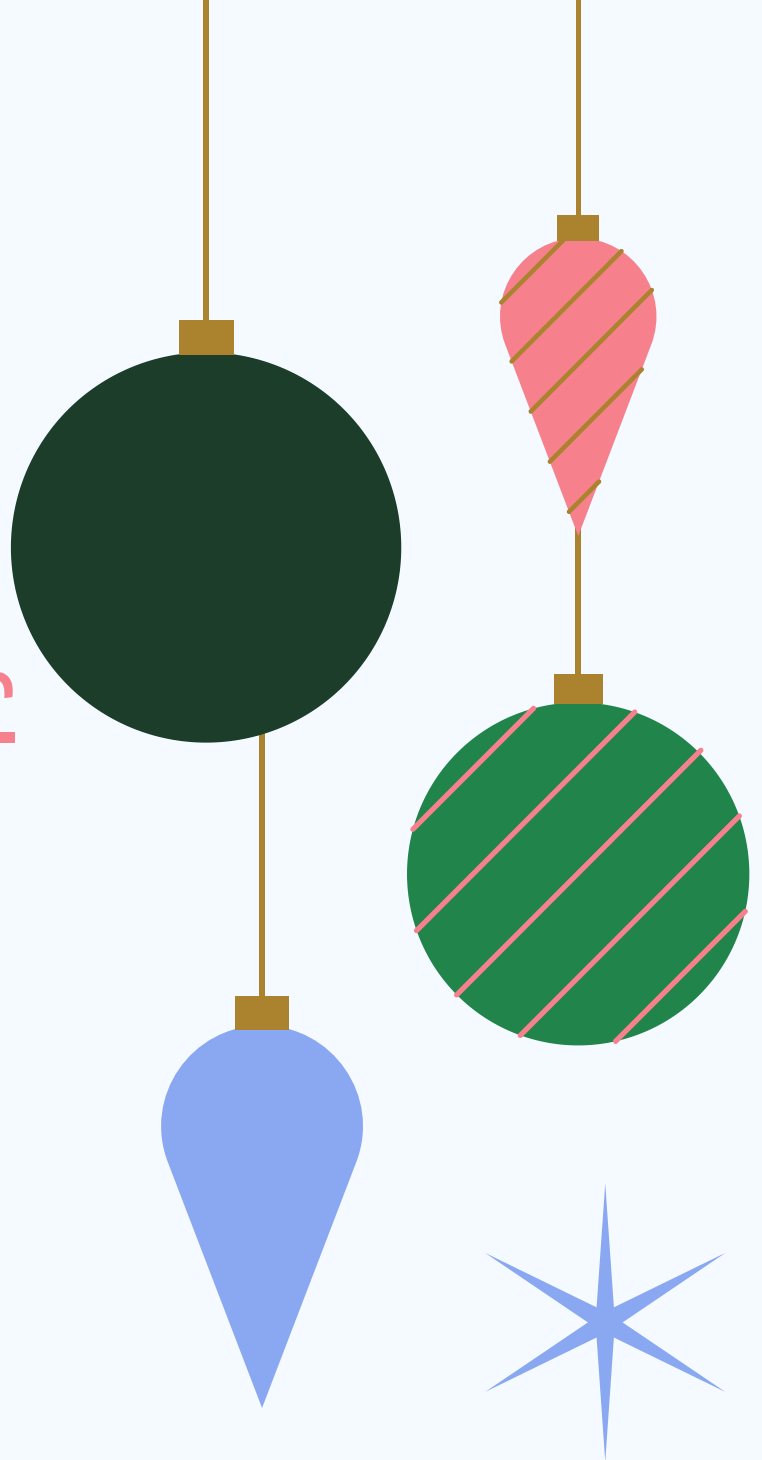


What a year 2021 has been!
