







# Reading map

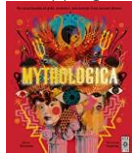
## Year 5 - Year A cycle (2020-21)

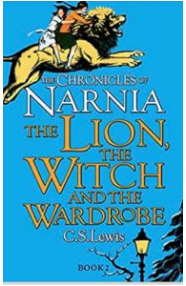
In B cycle (2021-22), Year 5 were, as they used to be, split across Year 4/5 and Year 5/6 so followed the books on their respective curriculum plans.

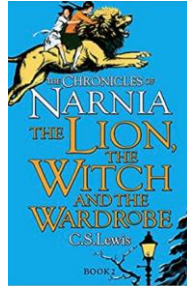

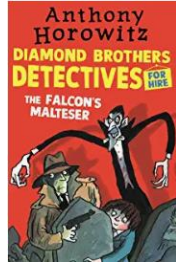

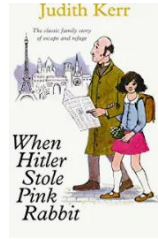
