Class Dojo

Thank you! Many of you have now signed up to Class Dojo so promptly.

This is our online learning platform, where we can share pictures and updates of your child's development and learning during their time here. If you haven't yet signed up and/or are experiencing troubles, please let us know.

It is a completely safe, secure site only accessed by yourself and school staff.

You will get a snapshot of what your child is doing both on their own personal profile page and as a group on the class story tab. Ensure you check both to stay up to date.

We would like to create a family book for our book area, can we ask you to upload a couple 2/3 pictures of special people to your child. You will need to leave a brief text to help me with names. These should be uploaded to your child's personal profile/portfolio page. The children love seeing themselves in a book and chatting about siblings, parents and grandparents between each other.

Water bottles are not required in preschool, we have fresh water readily available throughout the day. If you wish your child to have one with their packed lunch then please ensure its labelled and with their lunch bag.

Packed lunches Please ensure they are healthy with all fruit chopped in half lengthways including small fruits such as raspberries, grapes and blueberries to avoid a choking hazzard. Only one small biscuit treat is acceptable. Please NO GLASS tupperware as lunchbags are frequently dropped, and well handled(!). We are nut free.

Clothes and footwear Red tops are great for helping your child feel part of our school community and save home clothes from becoming soiled. Please label all items as children do not always recognise their belongings and matching 20 children to the correct items can be time consuming we would rather spend time with the children. Trainers or other easy shoes are best for all our indoor and outdoor pursuits. Children will be encouraged to learn to do these themselves so ensure they are managable for them.
