

Stockbridge Primary School – Uniform

School uniform offers children a sense of belonging.

When thinking about this, the children gave these reasons for wearing uniform:

- ✓ It shows we represent the school
- ✓ It promotes a team spirit
- ✓ We all look smart

Uniform consists of:

Items available to purchase through the school office. All items have Stockbridge Logo where applicable	Items to purchase from retailer
Red sweatshirt or cardigan	Grey or black trousers or grey skirt
White shirt, blouse or polo shirt (During class time these should be tucked in – therefore please avoid buying “fitted” blouses or similar clothing which makes this difficult)	Red and white gingham or striped dress in summer
Plain or ‘Stockbridge’ polo shirt in summer	White or grey socks
Red fleece or reversible fleece/raincoat	Black or brown shoes (no high heels, clogs or trainers, please)
Nametapes and Shoe/equipment labels	Sensible sandals, which may be worn in summer

PE Kit consists of:

‘Stockbridge’ red polo shirt / T shirt / plain top	Black or navy shorts
Red PE bag standard/deluxe	Plimsolls or trainers
	Jogging bottoms, which may be worn in winter
	Art / craft overall will be required to protect clothing - an old shirt can be used

PE Kit should be brought into school on a **Monday morning** in a **small** named bag and hung from your child's coat peg. It should remain in school until **Friday afternoon** to return home for washing.

Please collect an order form from the school office and return the completed form before the end of each calendar month. Orders will be placed with our supplier each month throughout the year. In July, please ensure your order is placed well in advance of the end of the school year.

Please remember to label clearly all of your child's clothing.

Hair styles:

Should be sensible and should not include those that involve large amounts of hair gel or fashionable 'lines' being cut into the sides of the head.

Jewellery:

Children should wear only a watch and *stud* earrings to school; rings, bracelets and necklaces are not allowed for health and safety reasons.

**County stipulates that jewellery MUST NOT be worn for PE lessons.
If your child is unable to remove stud earrings, please provide plasters so
that they can be covered.**
